
How much do you trust the United Nations? (%) CRRC DI 2009 [P4_16]

■ Armenia ■ Azerbaijan ■ Georgia




Trust toward EU (5-point scale, '1' means "fully distrust," and '5' means "fully trust")





Our way of life needs to be protected against European influences. (positive answers only; %) CRRC DI 2009 [IR1]



Our way of life needs to be protected against Russian influences.







Our way of life needs to be protected against American influences. (positive answers only; %) CRRC DI 2009 [IR3]




Do you have a job? (%) (Caucasus Barometer 2010)




Minimal monthly income for a normal life; in local currency (%)






