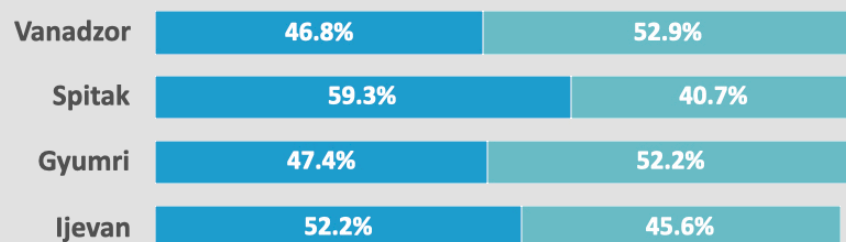

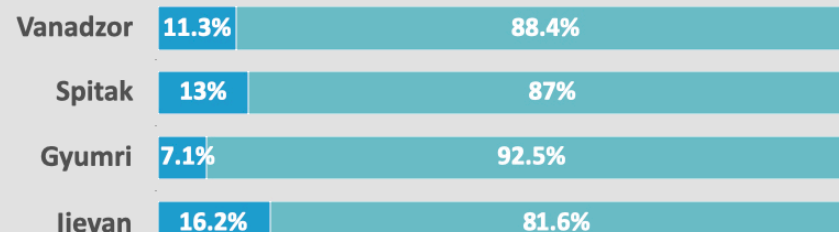

OVERVIEW

According to the World Bank Report - The many faces of Deprivation: A Multidimensional Approach to Poverty in Armenia (2017), more than 0.18 million Armenians fall below the national food poverty line. This group of individuals are vulnerable to changes including a reduction in income, since they are already living in a state of absolute or relative deprivation of material goods.

This data was collected from The Community Poverty Reduction “Know How” Project. The research was conducted in August 2021 in the Tavush, Lori, and Shirak Marzes with 2376 respondents in total. The purpose of this survey was to understand and document the different realities of the residents living in these Marzes.
